Supply list

- **Rotary cutter and mat**
- **Quilting ruler**
- **Small scissors**
- **Pins and or sewing clips**
- **Pressing spray** or spray starch
- **Thread**
- **Sewing Machine:** a quarter inch **piecing foot** is recommended.
- **Pedal and Cord** for your sewing machine!
- **Wedge ruler ---or printed paper template:** A printable 10-degree wedge template is included. *Cut both the templates out carefully* if you are using these. You will also need some **clear tape** to attach them to your ruler (we will go over how to do this in class). If you have an acrylic wedge ruler, that is even easier to use than templates! I recommend the **Creative Grids 10-degree Triangle** ruler if you would like to use a specialty ruler.
- **Colored pencils** for planning your design. (optional)
- **Book: Wedge Quilt Workshop** (optional! It's not needed for the class but if you love what wedges can do, this book is the next step.)

Fabric requirements

Bring any fabric you are excited to work with – ideally at least 7 different fabrics. More is fine! Less might be fine but you will be more limited with design choices. Fat quarters will be plenty or see precise dimensions below:


Suggestions:

5 pieces of fabric that blend well with one another 9" x 14" each


1 piece of fabric that contrasts (to form the central star) 9" x 14"

1 fat quarter or a strip 4 1/2" x 40" for the triangle points.


I invite you to follow your design instincts. You can use any fabric you want to play with!
